Day by Day Programme

17th November

Arrival at International Airport *Francisco Sá Carneiro*, *Porto*. Private transfer to Tiara Hotel: accreditation at reception. Rest of day: free.

18th November

Depart Tiara Hotel to a full-day guided tour to the Douro Valley, Unesco World Heritage since 2001. During this day we will drive through the mountains; crossing Marão Mountain we will arrive at Régua, cross the Douro River and proceed to visit Quinta do Seixo. This Port wine farm belongs to the international brand Sandeman and is one of the most modern Port wine production centres in the *Douro* Valley; at the end of the guided tour, Port wine tasting. Continue to Quinta da Pacheca: this family owned state farm, will give us a different perspective of the Port wine production. Lunch will be served and in the afternoon, we will visit the new Douro Museum. Return to Porto and free rest of day.





19th November

Depart Tiara Hotel to Quinta da Aveleda: today we will focus your wine tour on Vinho Verde. Arrival at Quinta da Aveleda, visit through the gardens, farm and winery. This family run state farm produces one of the best known Vinho Verde sold around the world in more than 150 countries: at the end of the tour Vinho Verde tasting. Continue to Guimarães, cradle of Portugal and Unesco World Heritage. Lunch will be served at *Pousada* de Santa Marinha da Costa, sponsored by Pestana Hotéis and Pousadas de Portugal. After lunch continue to visit the historical city, the Sacred Hill, where we can find the symbols of Portugal. The Castle, São Miguel Chapel, Afonso Henriques' statue, and the Braganza Ducal Palace. Our walking tour will continue towards Rua de Santa Maria, Praça de Santiago and Praça da Oliveira. Return to Porto and rest of day at leisure.









20th November

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Morning city tour of Porto, visiting the Palácio da Bolsa, São Francisco Church and Henry the Navigator Square. Our tour will continue for the visit to the Porto Cathedral, Praça da Batalha, Igreja dos Clerigos and Lello Bookshop. Free time for lunch. In the afternoon a FEG SEMINAR (OPTIONAL- more information will be forwarded soon by FEG Secretariat) will be held in Tiara Hotel. Dinner at Grande Hotel Do Porto

21st November

Delegates - FEG AGM to be held at Tiara Hotel.

Guests – Full day Tour to Braga, the Portuguese Rome, - Visit to the Cathedral, and *Bom Jesus do Monte* Sanctuary. Continue to *Barcelos*, famous for the rooster – symbol of Portugal's Handicraft – lunch at a local restaurant. Continue to Viana do Castelo, visit to Republic Square, were we can find the old Town Hall, Hospital and *Misericórdia* church. Return to Porto... and prepare yourself for dinner.
